Formulation Counts and the New Survey Process

Collecting the number of Fragrance material formulations per product

What is it?

A new step when completing a RIFM Survey designed to capture the number of fragrance material formulations per product that are currently produced by companies that complete RIFM Surveys.

Why do we want this information? Where and when to access the

These data will allow us to include occurrence data in the Creme RIFM Model. Currently, the Creme RIFM Model assumes that all products contain all fragrances which is a conservative assumption. With the new data on the number of formulations produced per product, we can further refine the fragrance exposure assessments and obtain even more realistic results.

Where and when to access the Formulations Count File?

Formulations Count file can be accessed on the same <u>Data portal</u> you have been using and the number of formulations with be available from Survey 39.

Formulation Counts and the New Survey Process

How to enter the new required information?

There is a new Formulations Count File where the number of fragrance material formulations with be entered. This is a required step and the Formulations Count File needs to be completed and submitted before entering the fragrance concentrations. Only one value should be entered per product. This value represents the number of Fragrance material formulations that the company produces.

No empty values are allowed. If your company produces no fragrance compounds for a given product, please enter a value of zero.

Step by Step Guide to the new Survey Process

Log in to Data Portal as usual. The starting page has now been updated. Companies are now required to fill in a Formulation Count File before entering the fragrance concentration.
